October 15 - 22, 2016



Arrival: October 15, 2016

Airport pick up and a tour of Kingston or Montego Bay (depending on the arrival airport). Two hours scenic drive to Mandeville, a beautiful lush green, peaceful and cozy town in center of the island, sitting high up in the mountains. A warm welcome in Mandeville accompanied by an authentic Jamaican dinner cooked by our Resident Chef. After dinner, relax, enjoy, unpack and mingle.

Sunday, October 16, Beach Day

Start with a warm traditional breakfast, grab your beach towels, hop in the vehicles and head straight for the beach...and it's no ordinary beach, it's the Blue Fields beach, a hidden secret among the locals. Bask in the sun, enjoy the waves, go for a swim and have a fun, and relaxing day on a secluded beach. Enjoy the sunset and then head back towards Mandeville. By the time we arrive, dinner will be ready, prepared by our Resident Chef, made from locally grown organic vegetables, meats and fruits. Enjoy a night cap on the patio while feeling the cool evening breeze, or head to your room to rest up and get ready in the morning for the first excursion.

Excursion 1: Monday, October 17 to Tuesday October 18

After the breakfast we head out to Dunns River Falls, known to be second most famous waterfalls after Niagara Falls. After enjoyig lunch near this nature's marvel, we will drive towards Robins Bay, Portland and St. Mary. Just driving up to this area is breath-taking. The lush green farm fields merging right up with the edge of the ocean. The high cliffs and small sandy beaches of this fertile farm land, offer views of the ocean that rival some of most desired travel destinations in the world. A scenic drive along the coast, will take us to our home for the night in Robbins Bay. It will be a real treat if it is raining. There is nothing else like sitting under a tin roof and listening to the relaxing sound of rain drops falling on it while tasting locally grown fresh fruits. Just the sounds of nature as the night falls, will you make feel like you are in the middle of a rain forest. You would be excited to wake early and enjoy the stunning view from your balcony. Walk out of your room on the balcony and witness nature in its purest and most beautiful form. It's nothing short of paradise on earth. After the breakfast and mingling with our hosts in Robins Bay, we will head out to Port Royal...yes the same Port Royal where the real Pirates of the Caribbean operated from and struck fear in the hearts of the passengers of the ships that entered the Caribbean ocean. In 1907, a major earth quake tore off a part of the island from the rest, sinking most of the port and ships whose remain are still visible. Scuba divers come from around the world looking for the treasures hidden inside the sunken ships of the famous Pirates of the Caribbean. From Port Royal, we will head back towards our home base in Mandeville, enjoy an authentic Jamaican lunch along the way and get home just in time for dinner followed by a night of restful sleep.

Wednesday, October 19

Start with a cultural experience in Mandeville. After breakfast, we will head towards the local street market where hundreds of vendors gather to sell fruits, vegetables, crafts and other local items. You get to practice your haggling skills and if have none, we will be happy to give you a crash course:-) Shopping here or even going to the market is a unique and fun experience. Ladies, be prepared for the local men showering you with compliments (in a very respectful and playful Jamaican way). After enjoying a freshly prepared lunch we can either hang out or take a nap to be ready for the treat that awaits us that evening in Little Ochie, a small fishing village, where fishermen catch fresh fish and grill it on coals right on the beach. Here you will find the most fresh seafood, have it cooked in front of your eyes and enjoy it sitting in little grass huts along the beach, watching the ocean waves glowing under the moonlight.

Thursday, October 20

We will leave for Westmoreland, a little farming community nested between the rolling green hills lined with breadfruit trees. Yes, it's a fruit that tastes just like bread and we know you won't believe it until you actually try one. What comes after that is simply cuteness overload. Little Piglets, baby goats, chickens, rabbits, it's like a petting zoo surrounded by breath-taking mountains. If you are feeling adventurous enough, we will show you how to properly pick up a piglet and guess its weight. After a playful and fun afternoon at the EVA Fresh Farms in Westmoreland, we head to Margaritaville in Negril, one of the best places to watch the sun setting on the Caribbean ocean while sipping on your favorite drink and listening to music. We will spend the night in Negril at an ocean front property.

Rest, Relax and Rejuvenate... the following night in Mandeville is going to be the most fun, high energy, entertaining and authentic part of Jamaican culture, a real reggae party with local DJs, entertainers, karaoke and performances, right in our backyard where dinner will roasted a few feet away on open fire as you listen to island rhythms. After all, it is your last night on the island and we have got to make it the night to remember.

After enjoying a delicious home cooked Jamaican breakfast prepared by our Resident Chef, we will take you to the airport to send you on your way back with a smile on your face, memories to last a lifetime and a heart full of love and joy.
